OVERVIEW OF POSITION

All bartenders are responsible for assisting in the overall successful service of the event, with a primary focus on high level beverage service. You should perform all duties assigned to you by onsite Kitchen Lead and contribute as an active and eager part of the team. Duties will include unloading event truck, event setup, beverage service, and event breakdown.

QUALIFIED APPLICANTS SHOULD:

- Have minimum 2 years experience or bartender training course completion with certification
- Possess current TIPS certificate or equivalent
- Be able to provide an exceptional bar experience (with knowledge, ability, and personality)
- Have an ongoing "How Can I Help?" attitude
- Be invested in delivering a successful event to our clients who we feel are treasured family!
- Be able to proactively think about the needs of the client, guests, and onsite kitchen lead
- Have an ongoing interest in the Fork in the Road menu and ingredients so you can answer guest questions
- Balance/carry trays of food and beverage
- Serve, pour, bus beverages
- Remain calm, positive, and friendly in high pressure environments
- Be able to communicate effectively to the onsite kitchen lead
- Be able to be on your feet, standing/walking for long periods of time
- Be able to regularly lift/move up to 25 lbs and occasionally up to 100 lbs.
- Have a high level of personal hygiene.
- Possess a California Food Handler's card.
- Always have reliable transportation and clean driving record.
- Understand that night and weekend availability are a must.
